

CHAPTER 119: VENDING MACHINES

119.01 Licenses required for vending machines

§ 119.01 LICENSES REQUIRED FOR VENDING MACHINES.

(A) No person, firm, or corporation shall operate or have on any premises, any coin-operated product vending machine, without having first obtained a license.

(B) The annual license fee for vending machines shall be as follows:

- (1) 1 or 2 machines at the same location: \$25;
- (2) 3 to 5 machines at the same location: \$50;
- (3) 6 to 10 machines at the same location: \$75;
- (4) 11 to 15 machines at the same location: \$100;
- (5) 16 to 20 machines at the same location: \$125;
- (6) 21 to 25 machines at the same location: \$150;
- (7) More than 25 machines at the same location: \$175.
