

MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING
2002 TAX LEVY

President Stricker stated the purpose of this Public Hearing is to review the 2002 tax levy.

2002 TAX LEVY

Trustee Ashmore arrived at 7:07 p.m.

Mary Britton, Director of Finance, reviewed the 2002 tax levy for the Board. She noted that the proposed impact using a tax rate of 16%, which is allowed by Statute, on a \$100,000 house would be \$4.00. The proposed impact using a tax rate of 10%, which is typically used in practice, on a \$100,000 house would be \$2.00. She also pointed out that the Board has the responsibility to approve the Library's tax levy, which was prepared by the Library. The Library's levy has no affect on the Village's tax rate; it is incorporated with the Village levy for filing purposes.

President Stricker asked if there were any questions or comments from anyone in the audience. There being none, Trustee Brown moved to close the Public Hearing at 7:15 p.m. Seconded by Trustee Johnson.
