Illinois Energy Now provides millions of dollars each year to help public entities reduce their energy costs, by improving the efficiency of their facilities. Upgrade your electric and natural gas equipment and save your communities money, by tapping into Illinois Energy Now rebates today.

### Who is eligible?

Illinois Energy Now funding and services are available for all public facilities located within Ameren Illinois and ComEd electrical service areas, or Ameren Illinois, Nicor, North Shore or Peoples natural gas areas. Examples include:

- Local Government (municipal, county, township, public safety, water and sewer districts, library and park districts)
- State and Federal Agencies
- Public Schools
- Community Colleges
- Public Universities

### Energy Efficiency Opportunities

#### **REBATES**

- **Standard & Custom Rebates:** “Menu” of rebates for energy efficient products (examples: lighting, HVAC), or a rebate of \$0.12/kWh and \$2.50/therm based on annual energy savings.
- **Clean Water Energy Efficiency Initiative:** Bonus rebate for high efficiency aeration systems at public waste water treatment facilities.
- **Combined Heat and Power (CHP):** Rebates for CHP projects that increase energy efficiency.
- **New Construction:** Rebates for buildings constructed to achieve energy efficiency beyond code requirements.
- **Public Housing Efficient Living:** Incentives to Public Housing Authorities to make energy efficient upgrades to buildings.

#### **FREE PRODUCTS & SERVICES**

- **Savings Through Efficiency Products (STEP):** Free assessment and high-quality energy savings products for new Illinois Energy Now customers.
- **Assessments:** Learn more about how your facilities use energy and opportunities for improvement with a building energy assessment tailored to your needs.
- **Tune-Ups:** Retrocommissioning can help identify measures to improve the control, scheduling, and operation of building systems. Customers can also focus on heating system efficiency, with a comprehensive boiler tune-up.
